- ✓ Corrugated Cardboard (cut down 2'x2' size)

- ✓ Small Scrap Metal Items / License Plates (No clothing hangers)
- ✓ Household Batteries (AA, AAA, C, D, 9 volt
 in clear zip lock baggies)

PAPER PRODUCT RECYCLING

Place all paper recyclables in brown paper or plastic grocery bags in, on top or next to your recycling bin.

CARDBOARD (See Guidelines Below)







EMPTY METAL CANS and SMALL SCRAP METAL ITEMS







PAPER, PAPERBACK BOOKS, MAIL, NEWSPAPERS, **MAGAZINES & PAPERBOARD BOXES:**

Mix together in paper or plastic grocery bag; no hardcover books





ALL **PLASTIC CONTAINERS** 1 through 7 Discard hard

plastic tops

CARDBOARD PREPARATION

OPTION ONE: Unfold, flatten,

cut to 2' x 2' size and bundle with twine or tape and place inside, next to or under bin.



OPTION TWO:

Unfold, flatten and stuff smaller boxes into larger box (no larger than 18"W x 24"L x 24"H along with other fiber items and place inside or next to bin.)
